- MUST be able to attend the USApple Annual Conference in August 2021
- MUST be willing to submit photos/videos and attend virtual events

Each YAL class will consist of a diverse makeup from apple-producing states. Class size will vary depending on the number of applicants. All who are eligible are encouraged to apply.
